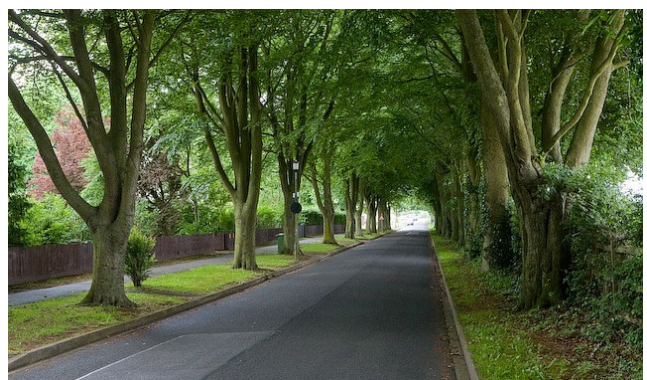

The Active Transportation Program (ATP) administered by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), is expected to award about \$650 Million through FY 2023-24 to 2026-27. The Program encourages an increased use of active modes of transportation, such as biking and walking by achieving the following goals:

- Increase the number of trips accomplished by biking and walking.
- Improve the safety and mobility of non-motorized users.
- Implement active transportation projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- Enhance public health, including reduction of childhood obesity.
- Provide a broad spectrum of projects to benefit many types of active transportation users.
