



# City of Huron COVID-19

## Residential Assistance Grant Program

### Eligibility Criteria & Program Guidelines

The City of Huron has created a Residential Assistance Grant Program to help offset the economic impacts from COVID-19. This program offers a grant to assist current eligible residents with expenses stated below, who have been affected by COVID-19. Only one grant may be awarded for each physical address.

#### The grant may be used to pay for:

- Rent/Lease/Mortgage Payment

#### Eligibility for the program is limited to residents that meet all of the following:

- Current City of Huron Resident
- Applicant is 18 years old or older
- Social Security Card
- State of CA Identification Card or Driver's License with Huron Address (copy not allowed)
- Current Pacific Gas and Electricity (PG&E) invoice (not more than 30 days from 10/01/20)

#### How to apply:

- Submit a complete application by mail (postmarked before 10/31/2020) or office door window drop in
- Submit copies of Social Security & Identification
- Submit proof of monthly rent/lease/mortgage payment (copy of rent/lease/mortgage contract and bank statements showing payment)
- Submit proof of a current Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) utility bill (copy of this utility bill and bank statements showing payment)

**Funding for the Resident Assistance Grant Program will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis until designated funds for the program have been exhausted. The City's determination whether to award grant funds shall be based on meeting the eligibility criteria and/or whether awarding grant funds is consistent with the overall goals and objectives of the program. An applicant may appeal any such determination to the City Manager, whose decision shall be final.**

**Please allow up to 60 days from the application deadline to receive an update of your application. All applicants will be notified by mail.**
